## Art Genève 2026

**Palexpo, Geneva** - Today the 14th edition of **Art Genève** closed its doors after another successful year reporting 28'000 visitors.

"My initial positive outlook has been substantiated by the many sales that I heard about in private conversations as well as what gallerists told reporting media," said **Art Genève** director **Charlotte Diwan**. She continued, "I was happy to read about strong sales at **Hauser & Wirth**, **Templon** and **Galerie Urs Meile**. It's great to see that dealers have generally adapted quickly to the art market's perceived downturn and brought works catering to the visitors of the salon and its size."

"In the Swiss city, it now runs "like clockwork"", **Le Figaro**'s Beatrice de Rochebouet wrote of this year's Art Genève adding that..."its greatest asset is its solid contingent of buyers from all corners of this small country, where wealth remains well hidden in safes." Sarah Moroz of international publication **The Observer** highlighted the "historically significant works changing hands without the pressure of marquee-market theatrics".

As every year, the commercial galleries were at the heart of this year's edition, but the 27 institutions showcasing their individual programmes also garnered much attention. The **MAMCO**, Genève, **Centre d'Art Contemporain** Genève and **Musée d'art et d'histoire de Genève** were all among the returning exhibiting institutions. **Art Genève Musique**'s performance evening **BEFORE DEMOLITION** at the brutalist **Temple de la Servette** was hugely popular with **Monica Bonvicini**'s performance an artistic highlight. This year's **Prix Solo Art Genève-Piaget** was awarded unanimously to **Maximilian William** from London for his presentation of the work of **Reginald Sylvester II**. Also awarded at **Art Genève**, the 30th **Prix Mobilière** art prize was awarded by the Mobiliar insurance company to **Cassidy Toner** for her ironic and critical examination of the art world.

The social highlight of the week was the annual gala dinner which was attended by over 1700 invited guests catered for by the culinary team of **Palexpo**.
